

COMPOSITION, SCOPE, PROCEDURE FOR AREA 93 REGISTRATION COMMITTEE

The **C.C.A.A. Registration Committee's** purpose is to maintain records of registered groups, G.S.R.'s, Area Committee members (including past delegates), liaisons, and all alternates, to provide this information to the G.S.O. Records Department, and to register attendance of G.S.R.'s, Area Committee members, and liaisons at Area assemblies. The committee also maintains descriptions and maps of the Central California Area and the districts within the Area and studies proposals for formation of new districts and modification of existing district boundaries and to make an impact report to the Area Committee.

MEMBERSHIP: Any interested AA member is eligible to be an area Registration committee member. Districts are also encouraged to form Registration committees and have district representatives on the area committee. The Area Registrar also attends the committee meetings.

BUDGET: The annual budget for each committee shall be handed to the Committee Chairperson by the Area Treasurer. Any funds required over budget may be requested by the Chair that committee or an appointed member of the committee, by first visiting the Finance Committee meeting at an Area Assembly. The Finance Committee shall advise the member whether or not the funds are available. If the funds are available, the member shall ask the Area Chair to add the request to the agenda for consideration by the Area Assembly. If the Area Chair adds the item/s to the agenda, the assembly shall vote on the request for the additional funds. If the Area Chair does not add the items to the Area Assembly, the member may request that the item be added to the next scheduled Area Assembly
